"From the Ground Up, Inc.":*

At the homeless shelter in Chico we provide workshops that teach money and time saving solutions.

Clients purchase dry ingredients in bulk; this greatly reduces cost. We teach them how to pre-measure jars with recipes for their favorite soups, stews, etc. and put them on a shelf.

The purpose is that anytime they get off work tired and have a family to feed they can now do so in 20 minutes, with a **nutritious meal for pennies each.**

Recently one of the students, a little boy who was about 8 years old hugged me and said, "This will be me and my mom's first meal when we get a real house again, thank you!"

They have since found housing, employment and use the money and time saving techniques they learned while living in the shelter. They also now have their own garden and use what they've learned about nutrition daily.



From the Ground up Farms is a volunteer led United Way partner agency. They plant Community Gardens and teach nutrition workshops all around Butte County and surrounding areas.
